Next Shipment of Water Purification Systems



The Southwest District Mission Program, Inc. (SWDMP) has confirmed with Agape Flights the next shipment of Water Purification System (WPS) to Cuba will be July 30th.

I met with Kenn Visser of Water One, Inc. and have ordered construction of the first ten systems. We can order more systems in lots of ten minimum units until May 1st.

Orders are not complete until SWDMP has received fifty percent (50%) of the total cost at that time your order will be placed. All orders are on "first come basis" to be included on this flight.

We are initialing a new program that may be of interest to some parishioners, "Adopt a Water System."

This could be accomplished in different ways:

- ***A church in the United States could purchase a system for an individual church in Cuba.***
- ***A family in United States could do the same, maybe for a one time family church in Cuba.***
- ***System could be purchased as a Memorial of a loved one here or in Cuba.***
- ***System could be purchased in Honor of person or family member.***

If there were other ideas and thoughts they would be looked at on an individual basis.

AWAY!

Please know we do not want to bring hardship on family members still living in Cuba, keep that in mind.

The cost of the system is \$2,400. Breakdown as follows:
