Email received from one of our Cuban Pastors telling of their difficult situation.

Dear Brothers & Sisters,

In this last year as you know and now more in this last month, the economic situation is very difficult as ever here in Cuba.

Please we need your prayers for our country in this difficult moment that we are living with difficulties in the most basic needs. For example, with food, the electricity (we are living hours of blackouts and not only this but also most of the people cook with an electric cooker) and transportation is very little because there is not enough fuel. If we find fuel it is very expensive according to our salary in Cuba. Fuel is the main reason for most of the shortcomings and needs.

We have many requests before God, as a local church, but the two most important and necessary right now are: To buy an generator and the gasoline that can help us to celebrate our services at times of power outages, which can also help many to come to the temple and use the electricity from that generator to cook their food. The church

then serves and helps everyone. The second main need is to pay a truck two times a week to take the congregation back and forth to services.

Your prayers are very important for us. I imagine you have seen in the news of your country, this situation for our whole island as never before. Imagine the National Assembly of Women in Canaan Camp was suspended.....
